Motion was made by Director Cox to approve the minutes from the August meeting. Director Redwine seconded the motion and the votes were 3 in favor, 0 against.

The investment reports were presented and reviewed by each board member. A motion was made by Director Cox to accept the following reports: Certificate of Deposit lists, Money Market Deposit, Bank account balance, Budget Vs Actual, Bank statements and Reconciliations and the ICS Money Market Account. Director Redwine seconded the motion and the votes were 3 in favor, 0 against.

Motion was made by Director Wilson to pay the bills as listed. Director Cox seconded the motion and the votes were 3 in favor, 0 against.

A public hearing was held regarding setting the tax rate for 2024- There was no opposition.

Motion was made by Director Cox to adopt the 2024 Tax rate at 0.007563 cents per \$100.00 value. Director Redwine seconded the motion and the votes were 3 in favor, 0 against. Voting for: Chad Cox, Tony Redwine, Brent Wilson. Attending not voting- Clayton McGilvray. Director Absent- Ken Dodson.
